TO: STAFF ORDERING CSE/IARTV YEAR 11 TESTS (UNIT 1 AND 2 STUDIES)

- 1 Accounting** (Time allocation: 90 minutes)
This draws primarily on material from Unit 2. However, where appropriate, aspects of Unit 1 will be addressed.
- 2 Biology** (Time allocation: 90 minutes)
This paper will be based on Unit 2 and will require students to answer multiple-choice and short-answer questions.
- 3 Chemistry** (Time allocation: 90 minutes)
This paper will primarily cover Chemistry concepts studied in Unit 2. However, where appropriate, aspects of Unit 1 will also be addressed.
- 4 Economics** (Time allocation: 90 minutes)
The Year 11 paper will cover material from both Units 1 and 2. The format will be similar to the 2006 Year 12 CSE/IARTV Test Paper. Students will be required to answer multiple-choice and short-answer questions.
- 5 Legal Studies** (Time allocation: 90 minutes)
The Year 11 Legal Studies paper will cover both Unit 1 and Unit 2. The paper will follow the format used on the 2006 CSE Test Paper. Questions on both Unit 1 and Unit 2 will range in length from short answer to extended response questions.
- 6 General Mathematics (A)**
General Mathematics A designed for students who may go on to Specialist Mathematics.
Six 20 minute multiple choice tasks and six 30 minute analysis tasks.
Schools may use these as separate tests or combine them into longer tests
- 7 General Mathematics (B)**
General Mathematics B for students who may go on to Further Mathematics.
Six 20 minute multiple choice tasks and four 30 minute analysis tasks.
Schools may use these as separate tests or combine them into longer tests.
- 8 Mathematical Methods - CAS (Unit 2)**
The Year 11 Mathematical Methods paper will cover Unit 2 and consist of:
 - four Skills Tasks, each of twenty minutes duration, and
 - four Analysis Tasks, each of twenty minutes duration.Schools may use these as separate tests or combine them into longer tests.
- 9 Physics** (Time allocation: 60 minutes)
The Year 11 Physics paper will cover Core Studies in Unit 2 - Motion and wave-like properties of light. (The paper will not cover the three detailed studies: Astrophysics; Investigations: Aerospace; or Investigations: Alternative Energy Sources.)
- 10 Psychology** (Time allocation: 90 minutes)
The Year 11 Psychology paper will consist of multiple choice and short-answer questions in the areas of Introduction to the Nervous System, Normality (ethics) and Social Influence. Parallel multiple-choice and short-answer questions are provided for the Options in Individual Differences.
