

# Exploring exciting learning projects through ICT and VELs

## PROGRAM OVERVIEW

VELs provides us with detailed statements about learning which can help us to develop curriculum and measure progress and achievement.

We all know that ICT in VELs is about using ICT for visual thinking, creating and communicating but how do we turn that into learning activities and assessment? The VELs learning statements are the signposts.

Creating 'aha!' moments however requires more than just these signposts. What are some great projects that bring together VELs, ICTs and other learning? This workshop will explore some project ideas that are drawn from VELs but aim to integrate learning experiences. The planning and assessment of such projects will also be explored.

## PROGRAM DETAILS

This workshop will be a hands-on opportunity to combine and exploration into how VELs is designed, with activities which demonstrate how to use the learning statements to develop curriculum. The focus will be on developing learning activities and assessment which combine learning about and through ICT with other areas of learning.

Ideas, projects and experiences will be shared and participants will also work to develop new projects.
