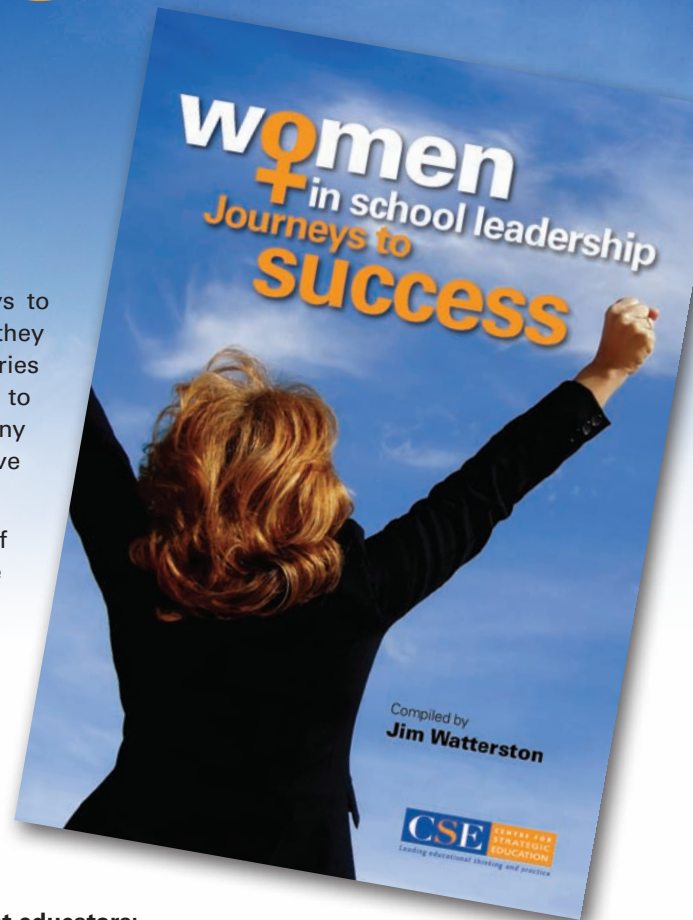
# women ♀ in school leadership Journeys to Success
